## ALCOHOL SOBRIETY FIELD TEST

### I. GENERAL

This Alabama Department of Corrections (ADOC) Administrative Regulation (AR) establishes the responsibilities, policies, and procedures to screen individuals suspected of being under the influence of alcohol.

### II. POLICY

It is the policy of the ADOC to test inmates, employees and visitors suspected of being under the influence of alcohol utilizing the electronic breathalyzer.

### III. DEFINITIONS AND ACRONYMS

- A. **Electronic Breathalyzer**: A device that measures the breath alcohol content of an individual.
- B. **Employee**: For this regulation, an employee is any full time, part-time, temporary employee, and other persons such as, but not limited to, contractors, vendors, trade school personnel and volunteers.

### IV. RESPONSIBILITIES

- A. Wardens/Division Directors/Designees are responsible for:
  - 1. Developing their facility/divisional Standard Operating Procedures (SOPs) as necessary for implementation of this AR.
  - 2. Ensuring staff are properly trained in the use of the electronic breathalyzer.
